

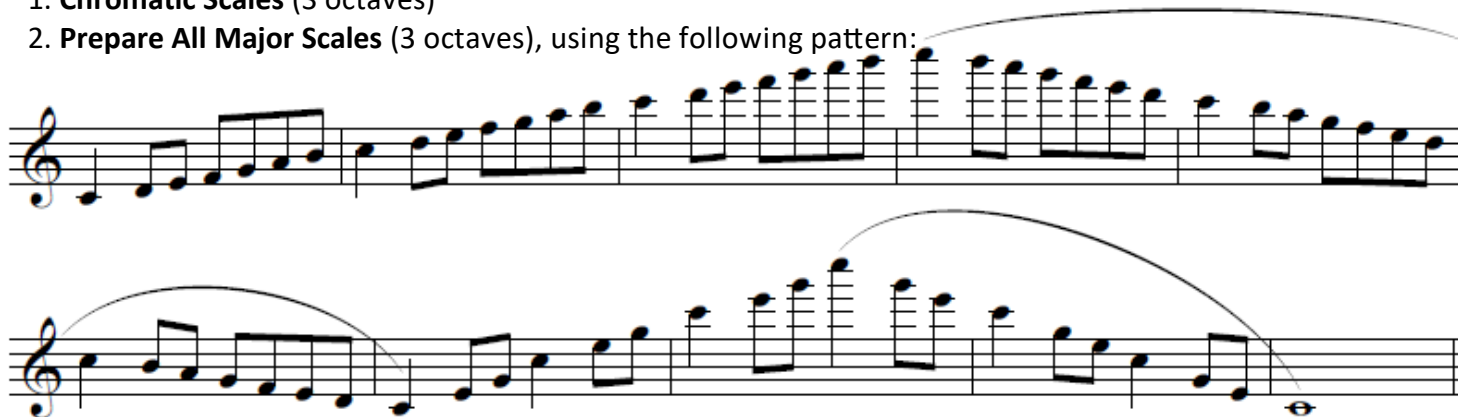

1) SCALES

(quarter note = 72 minimum)

1. **Chromatic Scales** (3 octaves)
2. **Prepare All Major Scales** (3 octaves), using the following pattern:



2) EXCERPT

1. Bizet - Intermezzo from Carmen, quarter note = 76

Nº 2. Intermezzo.

Andantino quasi Allegretto. ($\text{♩} = 88.$)



3) ETUDE

1. Anderson - Etude No. 2 in A minor from Op. 33, quarter note =116

a minor Moderato. ♩ = 116.

2. *p staccato*
